

## **Public Lands & Buildings Committee**

The Public Lands & Buildings Committee met on Monday, October 1, 2018 at 6:30pm in the Lyndhurst City Hall conference room to discuss the pool operations for the past season.

Present at the meeting were committee members Councilman Jeff Price, Councilman David Frey and Councilman Joe Marko.

Also present were Councilman Joe Gambatese, Councilman Lane Schlessel, Councilman Steve Grushetsky, Councilman Chuck LoPresti, Mayor Patrick Ward, Finance Director Mary Kovalchik, Service Director Tony Fioritto, Law Director Paul Murphy and Pool Supervisor Nicole Reichard.

The meeting was called to order at 6:35 PM.

Chairman Jeff Price began the meeting by discussing the financial reports prepared by the Finance Director.

Councilman David Frey commented on the admission fees for non-residents including the changes to the admission policy. He also discussed the disrespect he witnessed from pool guests to the life guards.

Councilman Chuck LoPresti remarked he received complaints for the first time this season.

Nicole Reichard shared complaints the pool staff received from residents regarding overcrowding.

It was moved to raise the age of children who can enter the pool without adult supervision from 8 years old to 11 years old. The motion passed 2-1; Councilman Joe Marko voting against the motion.

A recommendation was made to limit the summer camps allowed to enter the pool to only those camps located in Lyndhurst. A motion was made and passed 3-0.

Councilman Lane Schlessel suggested to table any further discussion regarding the increase of fees, petty cash and employee compensation until the preparation of the annual budget.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 7:25 PM
