Age requirements for patrol officer was discussed at length. Chief Rhode would like the same language for patrol officers as firefighters, as stated in Chapter 143.05 (b) of the codified ordinances of The City. “The Mayor may appoint any competent person not over forty (40) years of age to a full-time position in the Fire Department provided he has prior service as a firefighter and qualifies as being a member of the Ohio Police and Firemen’s Disability and Pension Fund. (Ord. 2015-48. Passed 7-16-15).”

Mr. Schmidlin stated that he would review the language change, and the change may have to be presented to council.

It was moved by Mr. Schmidlin, seconded by Ms. Sweeney that Section 141 of the Codified Ordinances of The City of Lyndhurst be amended, and to add Section 12 to mirror the existing language in 143.05.

The question was put to a voice vote and passed unanimously.
