INTRODUCED BY: MAYOR PATRICK WARD AND ALL MEMBERS OF COUNCIL

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING COMMENDATION AND SINCERE APPRECIATION TO PAUL THOMAS MURPHY FOR SERVICE RENDERED FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF LYNDHURST, OHIO AS DIRECTOR OF LAW
