

## **From The Service Department**

### Yard Waste

In 2010, with your help, the service department was able to collect over 1,100 tons of yard waste that would have previously been buried in the landfill. Together we saved over \$44,000 with this landfill avoidance. This year we would like to add to these numbers and bring down costs even further. Please remember to use the biodegradable brown paper yard waste bags or your designated yard waste cans. Yard waste only stickers are available at the service office 7:00am - 3:30pm, Monday through Friday and during our weekend rubbish hours of 11:30am – 3:30pm, Saturday and Sunday. Just place these stickers on your old rubbish cans (please limit size to 40 gallons and 40 pounds) to designate them as yard waste only and place at the curb 3 feet away from the rubbish and recycling containers. The yard waste truck is also available during our weekend rubbish hours.

Small tree trimmings 4 foot and under must be bundled with a bundled weight of no more than 40 pounds.

Large branches over 4 feet long (maximum 6 inch diameter) should be stacked neatly for chipping. Please keep brush at least 4 feet from all rubbish and recycling containers.

### Brainard Sprayground

Lyndhurst's new highly anticipated sprayground located at the former site of Brainard Pool was scheduled to open in conjunction with Lyndhurst Pool, but unfortunately Mother Nature has pushed the opening back. Hopefully this rain will stop and work can continue.

The sprayground will use the existing buildings and the concession stand will be open and run by the same company as Lyndhurst Pool. Not only will Lyndhurst have an additional feature to use, but we will greatly reduce operating costs of the former pool.
